

State Issues

- Karnataka's Maternal Mortality Ratio (MMR) reduced to 69 per lakh lives birth.
 Karnataka is one of the eight States in the country that have achieved the Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) target much ahead of schedule
- Vikram Kirloskar, the man who brought Toyota to Karnataka passed away
- Kutumba won the silver award for "Excellence in Governance Process Reengineering for digital Transformation" under national Award for e governance
- Archaeological Survey of India (Bangalore Circle) is preparing the "monument health card" for all 129 protected monuments across 17 districts in Karnataka to create a complete database of all monuments in its jurisdiction, for the first time
- According to the National Family Health Survey-5 (NFHS 2020-21), 65.5 per cent of children aged 6-59 months in Karnataka are anaemic.
- With an intent to promote sporting activities among the staff, the Karnataka State Fire and Emergency Services (KSFES) is all set to get a dedicated sports promotion board.
- Bengaluru will play host to the G20 Finance Ministers and Central Bank Governors' meeting
- **Kinnal toys** is a **traditional wooden craft** from the town of Kinhal(town is famous for Kinhal toys and religious idols) in **Koppal District** in Karnataka by **Chitragara artisans community**
- A delegation from the World Bank held discussions with the Karnataka government regarding the 'Resilient Karnataka Programme', aimed at making the state climate-resilient and also strengthen it to mitigate disaster risks, along with international expertise

- Yudh Abhayas is a joint military exercise between India –U.S conducted in Uttarkhand about 100km from Line of actual Control

- The oldest Muslim organisation in the country, Jamiat Ulama-i-Hind, has become the first Muslim body to accept caste-based Pasmanda Muslim identity of community members.
