- Philippines removes barrier in disputed Scarborough shoal, as china has installed 300-metre-long barrier at the entrance to the lagoon
- Black comedy 'Poor Things' wins Golden Lion at Venice directed by Yorgos Lanthimos and stared by Emma Stone
- Hong Kong's top court ruled in favour of recognising same-sex partnerships and
 gave the government two years to come up with a legal framework, but stopped
 short of granting full marriage rights to the city's LGBTQ community.



- Cuba has identified an alleged human trafficking ring aimed at recruiting its citizens to fight in Russia's war in Ukraine
- Iran recorded a heat index of 70 degrees Celsius (°C) in the coastal part of the country
- 18th East Asia Summit held in Jakarta
- Morocco sees its strongest earthquake in 120 years, the vast majority in Al-Haouz, the epicentre, and Taroudant provinces.
- India and Saudi Arabia sign Agreement on Cooperation Renewable Energy, Energy Efficiency, Hydrogen, Electricity and Grid Interconnection between the two countries, Petroleum, Natural Gas, Strategic Petroleum Reserves and Energy Security.
- UN warned that thousands of children are feared to be dying in Sudan as part of violence, disease and severe malnutrition rip through the conflict-torn country,.
 The UN refugee agency said more than 1,200 children in refugee camps had died since May due in part to a measles outbreak.
- Azerbaijan launched a military operation against the breakaway Nagorno-Karabakh region, warning it would "continue until the end" in the territory, over which it has fought two wars with neighbouring Armenia.
- Iran passed the strict dress code bill, mandating head coverings and modest clothing if not would face up to 10 years' prison
- U.S. offers temporary work permits to nearly 500,000 Venezuelans
- London's India Club, a meeting place for Indians in the United Kingdom during the independence movement, is set to close down permanently
- Military leaders of Mali, Niger and Burkina Faso sign mutual defence pact. Its aim is to "establish an architecture of collective defence and mutual assistance for the benefit of our populations"
- A Pakistan court raised an objection on a plea to reopen the case of Independence war hero Bhagat Singh's sentencing in 1931 and to set it aside by exercising the principles of review and honour him with posthumous state awards. The Lahore High Court also turned down the constitution of a larger Bench to listen to the petition.
- US envoy to Canada said that the Trudeau administration's claim of a link between the Indian government in killing of separatist Sikh leader Hardeep Singh Nijjar was based on "shared intelligence among Five Eyes partners"
- Iran's Revolutionary Guards "successfully" launched a new military imaging satellite "The Nour-3" placed in orbit 450 kilometres above earth
- **OSIRIS-REx** that carried sample from asteroid Bennu, made a successful return to Earth after seven years it was launched.
- Saudi Aramco announced its first global investment in liquefied natural gas, part
 of a broader bid by the energy giant to expand beyond oil. The company would
 acquire a minority stake worth \$500 million in MidOcean Energy, which is managed
 by the U.S. investment firm EIG.

• Taiwan's President launched the "Hai Kun" first domestically made submarine for testing at a port in Kaohsiung. The submarine, if successful in its tests, will be a major breakthrough for Taiwan in shipbuilding and design.

Environment

- In certain parts of Maharashtra, ephemerals wait for the monsoon season to bloom. They are any short-lived life cycle plant, usually one that has one or more generations per year.
- Researchers have recently investigated a nearly 520 million-year-old fossil of **Kylinxia zhangi** with a CT scanner and redescribed the animal.
- Maya Train project, connecting Caribbean with Maya sites been described as a "megaproject of death" causing "crimes of ecocide and ethnocide"
- The patent office of the Government of India has granted a patent to the Botanical Survey of India for 'reusable straw and its manufacturing'. The straw is developed from a species of endemic bamboo plant which is found on the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The bamboo species Schizostachyum andamanicum was discovered on the island about three decades ago and now its economic potential has got a new boost with this patent
- India celebrated its first anniversary of the arrival of eight African cheetahs from Namibia in Kuno National Park (KNP), Madhya Pradesh.
- According to a paper published in Nature, More than 75% of European bumblebee species may be threatened in the next 40-60 years
- Tamil Nadu, Kerala may join hands to count endangered Nilgiri tahr. For the first time, drones may be incorporated in the census, as the Nilgiri tahr prefers montane grasslands, with steep and rocky terrains at an altitude between 300 and 2,600 metres above sea level.
- **Kole wetlands of Kerala** face threat of alien plants. Cabomba furcuta, popularly called as Pink Bloom due its massive flowering, has been a new threat in addition to water hyacinth and Salvinia molesta

- Olympian Elavenil Valarivan won air rifle gold in Rio World Cup
- Hockey captain Harmanpreet Singh and Olympic medallist boxer Lovlina Borgohain will be the flag-bearers of the Indian contingent during the opening ceremony of the Asian Games
- The ICC confirmed that Broward County (Florida), Grand Prairie (Dallas) and Eisenhower Park (New York) will host matches in the USA-leg of the ICC Men's T20 World Cup next year. This is the first time the tournament will be played in USA and it will co-host it with the West Indies.



- Indian women's blind cricket team defeated Australia in the finals and won gold medal at the IBSA World Games in Birmingham, United Kingdom. India became the first ever cricket winners at the IBSA World Games.
- India beats Pakistan in penalty shootout, wins Men's Hockey 5s Asia Cup 2023 held at Salalah, Oman
- Coco Gauff clinched her first US Grand Slam title with a battling win over Aryna Sabalenka of Belarus.
